Grantmaking: \$965,901

Pass-through funds that depend upon annual gifts from supporters paid out **\$30,867** in 2014. The largest grants were from the **Fireworks** Fund, the **Jake Calvin Memorial** K-9 Fund, and the Community **Thanksgiving** Fund.

The Foundation's **General** fund provided **\$101,313** in grants, along with **\$18,692** from the **United Community Fund**. **Field of Interest Funds** granted **\$63,517**. **Agency Funds** provided **\$131,226** to the organizations they were created to support. **\$293,796** was paid by **donor-designated or advised ("Named")** funds.

Sustainability of the Tipton County Foundation

Donors occasionally contribute to TCF's management and operation but TCF currently conducts no campaign for its own benefit-- only for the causes supported by its various funds.

Sustainability for the management expenses comes from the proceeds of our investments in two ways. One way is by the proportional share allocated directly to the Foundation's own operating endowments. The other is from the fee (lowest in Indiana) paid by each component fund —out of the proceeds TCF itself allocated to the Fund!

No donor dollars are ever used unless given specifically for that purpose!



The Tipton County Foundation, the local Community Foundation, is a tax-exempt, nonprofit, autonomous, publicly supported, nonsectarian philanthropic institution.

Founded in 1986 and guided by civic-spirited Volunteers, its long-term goal is the building of permanent, named component funds, established by many separate donors to carry out their charitable intent.

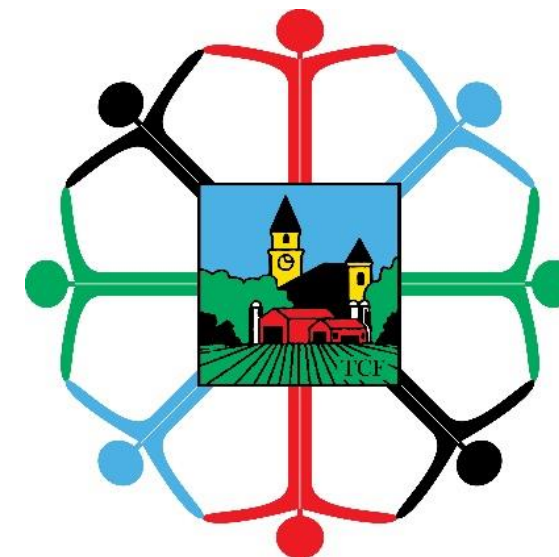
